Since our Summer Newsletter 3 months ago, we have been busy in a number of ways. We have ministered in churches in UK, namely Stockport, Lytham St. Annes and Barrow-in-Furness. Interestingly, Viv has been asked to lead worship a number of times recently - something he felt the Lord encourage him in earlier in the year.

At the beginning of September we travelled to North America for three weeks of ministry. Since returning to UK we have been at the Ocean Wings conference in Llandudno, Wales where we enjoyed good fellowship and ministry and helped to lead the times of worship.

The next events that Viv will be ministering at are a Cross-Cultural Forum of African church leaders in Manchester and a men's weekend retreat in Derbyshire. At the end of November he will travel back to India with Bruce Millar for the official opening of the Medical Centre and Children's home. We will also be spending time teaching and encouraging church leaders and Viv will be officiating at the wedding of D.B. Abraham's daughter, Hephzibah, on December 1st.

In the New Year Jean and I travel to Amiens and Le Mans in France where we will be ministering in a couple of churches and speaking at and participating in a week of prayer and fasting with around 100 Assemblies of God pastors regarding their national project M2. 'M' represents multiplication - every church to plant a church; every leader to reproduce a leader; and every disciple to make a disciple. We are very excited about this great opportunity to contribute to this wonderful vision.
