Greetings in the Matchless Name of Jesus!

We are currently going through a time of tremendous upheaval. Britain has voted to exit from the EU (even England has been knocked out of the European Football Championships); the value of the pound has plummeted; stock markets all around the world have been hit; migration worldwide is at an all-time high; and terrorism continues unabated.

The Good News is that Jesus is still Lord and the Kingdom of God is as stable as its ever been. The world's problems are colossal but, seen through a Kingdom lens, the opportunities may be unprecedented.

Recently I reported that we had to postpone our planned trip to France in January because Jean underwent a surgical procedure. All is now well with her and in May Viv was able to travel to Lyon for a few days to participate in progressing the project that was formulated in January when we were unable to be there. This exciting project, called M2 has been adopted nationally by Assemblies of God in France. M stands for multiplication. The vision is for every church to plant a church; every leader to develop a leader; and every disciple to make a disciple. I was able to challenge all the pastors present to consider how they might encourage an apostolic environment throughout their movement. I have been invited to continue to participate in the project, even possibly addressing the movement's National Executive Leadership. Wow! Please pray that the Lord would grant wisdom for this.



The next piece of good news is that the building of the medical centre and children's home in Isnapur, India is complete apart from some drain work. The next challenge is to raise the funds for furnishing and fully equipping the facility. The immediate budget for this is £3,700 for the children's home, kitchen and dining room and £3,150 for the medical centre and drain work.

All our funds are now completely depleted and so if you are able to help in any way, we would be extremely grateful. Please visit our website to find out how to contribute. For example, a contribution of £65 would provide a bed complete with mattress pillow and covers. A gas stove for the kitchen will cost £40. For the medical centre an examination bed costs £80, IV poles £30, stethoscope £30, blood pressure monitor £35, nebuliser £70, steriliser £33 and a fingertip pulse odometer is £20. So you can see that a donation of any size can provide much needed furniture and equipment.
